Taji and his brother, Chioke, grew up in Natchitoches, Louisiana and received degrees from Grambling State University. Upon graduating with a computer science degree, Taji couldn't find work in his chosen field. But unlike the thousands of young people who leave Louisiana to find employment, Taji decided to create his future right at home. Taji along with his brother, Chioke, started P.A.C., LLC in 2005, which is a commercial and residential construction company.

"My grandfather and uncle were carpenters, so I grew up around the construction industry. But we never actually worked construction. We took classes and got our commercial and residential contractors license," said Taji.

The brothers then came to the **LSBDC at Northwestern State University** for assistance in starting their business. Consultants helped them develop a business plan, assisted with a loan package, and provided business training. Last July, Taji and Chioke built and sold their first spec house for a profit. They are currently working on their second home and have contracts with the City of Natchitoches, including building the dug-outs for Highland Park's baseball field.
