TRAINING PROGRAM COMPONENTS

1 Educational Program

Free training sessions will enhance the owners' operational efficiency and capacity to grow their business through increased knowledge of best practices in the business world. Approximately 13 courses will instruct the participants on specific business concepts, including writing business plans, marketing and advertising, accounting best practices, industry lending practices and other areas.

IDA Savings Account
